This dry red wine has a spirited sort of elegance. It comes alive with delicate cherry and strawberry nuances, mingled with subtle chocolate flavors. Aged for 26 months in small oak barrels, this wine offers refined oak complexity, light tannins, and a lasting finish.

Cellar in a cool, dark place for prolonged quality and aging ability. Enjoy at room temperature.
